Wellness

For the month of April, we are going to talk about Citizenship. We will read stories and have discussions on how to become great citizens. We will continue with our weekly yoga session, breathing exercises, and our mandalas, which is a nice calming practice in the classroom.

Indigenous Learning

This week, we are going to continue to learn about the 7th and last Seven Sacred Teachings of the Indigenous People which is Truth. The Turtle is the symbol for Truth. We are going to use this symbol in our classroom over the next few weeks to help us learn that Truth is everything that is real, and that Truth is about living all the Seven Teaching – Love, Wisom, Humility, Courage, Respect, and Honesty.

Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, our "**nouvelle amie**" this week is **Agnès Agneau**, the sound is '**gn**'. Their homework this week will be Andrée Anguille, sound 'an' their sight words are ans, en, mange, and devant. Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the ones that are difficult.

Sight Words: quand (when), and **prend** (take)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will continue to learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather. We will also do attendance.

Writing: We are learning about reducing, reusing, recycling, and gardening as ways to help the Earth during Earth week. Earth Day is on Monday, April 22nd.

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

<u>Math</u>

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 80 this month? Can we skip count by 2's to 20, 5's to 50, and 10's to 100? Can we count backwards from 20? Can we read and write our numbers up to 20?

We will also read a word problem and make addition questions related to the problem. We will also learn that subtraction and addition are related. 3+4=7 7-4=3 or 7-3=4
