Wellness

In our Mindfulness lessons this week, we are going to talk about Generosity, since we are in the season of giving. We will discuss how generosity isn't always about giving gifts that have a monetary value, gifts can be other things as well. Sometimes, these gifts have a lot more meaning, especially when it comes from the heart. \P We will continue with our weekly yoga session, breathing exercises, and our mandalas, which is a nice calming practice in the classroom.

Language Arts

Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the ones that are difficult.

Sight Words: j'ai (I have)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will continue to learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather. We will also do attendance.

Writing: This week, we are going to write a paragraph about our elves by describing them.

If they want to, they can even add more sentences from they have learned, like if they have animals, what their mom's/dad's names are, brother/sister's, ...

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

Math

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it past 20? Can we count backwards?

We will continue to look at different representations of numbers from 1-10 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible, (dots and **tally**). We will match different representations of numbers together (ex: number with hands). We will count objects to 10 or more.

We will work on one more and two more than a quantity of objects or a number rolled.
