## Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, our "nouvelle amie" this week is Ève Escargot, the sound is 'è' Their homework this week will be Katherine Coccinelle, the sound ' $k / c$ ' and Charles Chat, the sound ' $c h$ ', and their sight words are court, courir, parce que, chat, chien, chez, and chaque. Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the ones that are difficult.
