## Learning Activities

Week of January 22-26, 2024

## Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, we are going to review é (Émilie Éléphant) and è (Ève Escargot. They can continue to review their homework sheets, sight words, and sounds. Do the ones that are most difficult, especially vowels, é and è.

## Sight Words: No new sight words.

Routine: In our morning routine, we will continue to learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather. We will also do attendance.

Writing: The next few weeks we are going to learn about our community. This week, we will look at the following:

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

## Math

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 50 this term? Can we skip count by 2 's to 10 ? Can we count backwards from 10? Can we read and write our numbers up to 20?

We will continue to look at different representations of numbers from 1-10 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible, (hands, dots, tally, ten frames, rekenrek, number) and explain how they know.

We are representing numbers up to 20 using hands, rekenrek, dots, ten frames, and with cubes.

We are subtracting 2 numbers with digits up to 10 .
