Wellness

Indigenous Learning

Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, we will learn **Zach Zèbre**, the sound 'z' and review our sounds learned this year. Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the vowels.

Sight Words: **garçon** (boy), **maison** (house), **bonjour** (hello), and **aujourd'hui** (today)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will continue to learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather.

Writing: This week, we are going to write funny sentences and draw our sentences. Students will pick from a list of who, what (actions), and where to create their sentences. Once they have created their sentence, they will draw it.

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the sentence structures we have learned this year.

Math

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we count backwards from 10? Can we read and write our numbers up to 10? We are looking at 2D shapes this week: square, rectangle, triangle, circle, and oval. We will look at their different characteristics.
