Wellness

This month, we are learning about perseverance. In our Mindfulness lessons this week, we are going to continue to do some yoga. We will also do more breathing techniques while encouraging students to reflect on how they felt during their day. We will also talk about our emotions and how we can experience many of them at the same time.

Indigenous Learning

Language Arts

Sight Words: auto (car) and chaud (hot)

Writing: We will continue our family members in French. This week, we will look specifically at grandparents.

Math

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 20?

We will continue to look at different representations of numbers from 1-10 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible, (dots, tally, ten frames, number, tally marks, and rekenred). We will match different representations of numbers together (ex: number with hands). We will count objects to 10 or more. We are starting to name the numbers in French when shown the number, as quickly as possible. Can they write them as well? We will also begin addition, using different strategies, while using the correct terms, plus, equal, and sum (plus, égal et somme)
