Learning Activities Week of October 10-12th, 2023

Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, we are going to be learning sounds in French. Every sound is accompanied with an animal. We call them our friend (ami) and there is also a song that goes with each sound. Our "**nouvel ami**" is **René Renard**, the sound is '**e**'. Their homework this week will be Francine Fourmi, the sound 'f', **Nicolas Nounours**, the sound '**n**', and their sight words are famille, fille, non, and animal. Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the ones that are difficult.

Sight Words: je (I) and regarde (look)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather.

Writing: This month, we will learn about family members in French, including our pets. This week, we will look specifically at mom and dad again.

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

<u>Math</u>

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 19? We will be looking at different representations of numbers from 1-10 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible. (dots, tally, ten frames, number, especially **ten frames** again this week). We will continue working on word problems. We will count objects to 10 or more. We are starting to name the numbers in French when shown the number, as quickly as possible. Can they write them as well?
