Wellness

In our Mindfulness lessons this weel, we are going to continue to talk about Thankfulness. We are also going to talk about when we are in the blue zone especially and look at different tools we can use to get to the green zone, such as our Calming Corner as a corner to let us get back to the green zone and different breathing techniques when we don't feel just right.

Indigenous Teaching

This week, we are going to continue to learn about the 2nd Seven Sacred Teachings of the Indigenous People which is Love. The eagle is the symbol for Love. Language Arts

Sight Words: le/la/les (the)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather.

Writing: The Fall season has now begun. Therefore, we are going to do a unit on the Fall. We are going to look at things we see in the fall and clothing we wear in the Fall.

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

<u>Math</u>

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 20?

We will be looking at different representations of numbers from 1-6 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible. (hand, dots, tally, ten frames, rekenrek, number, especially **Rekenrek** this week). We will count objects to 10 or more. Can they write the numbers up to 10 as I say them?
