In our Mindfulness lessons this week, since we are approaching Thanksgiving, we will also look at the importance of expressing gratitude. Saying Thank you is one way, but there are many other ways. During the week, we will also do some yoga and colour some madalas while listening to some calming music.

Indigenous Teachings

This month, we are going to continue to learn about the first Seven Sacred Teachings of the Indigenous People which is Respect. The Buffalo is the symbol for respect. We are going to use this symbol in our classroom over the next few weeks to help us learn about this very valuable trait and how it relates to how we treat others.

Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, we are going to be learning new sounds in French. Our "nouvelle amie" is **Francine Fourmi**, the sound is 'f' and **Nicolas Nounours**, the sound is 'n'. Their homework this week will be Isabelle Iguane, the sound 'i'. Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the ones that are difficult.

Sight Words: famille (family), **fille** (girl), **animal** (animal), and **non** (no)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's, yesterday's, and tomorrow's date, and the weather.

Writing: This month, we will learn about family members in French, including our pets. This week, we will look specifically at mom and dad.

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

Math

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 19?

We will be looking at different representations of numbers from 1-10 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible. (dots, tally, especially **Ten Frames** this week). We will count objects to 10. We will continue to name the numbers in French when shown the number, as quickly as possible.
