Language Arts

Reading: In Reading, we are going to be learning sounds in French. Every sound is accompanied with an animal. We call them our friend (ami) and there is also a song that goes with each sound. Our "**nouvelle amie**" is **Isabelle Iguane**, the sound is '**i**'. Their homework this week will be Martin Mouton, the sound 'm'. Please continue to also review other sounds and sight words, especially the ones that are difficult.

Sight Words: il (he), **ils** (they) and **il y a** (there are/is)

Routine: In our morning routine, we will learn the colours in French, the days of the week, and we will look at today's and yesterday's date. We will also start looking at the weather.

Writing: This week, we are going to learn about classroom/school objects and objects that we would put in our school bag.

Dans mon sac d'école, il y a ... (In my school bag, there is ...)

Dans ma salle de classe, il y a ... (In my classroom, there is ...)

Oral Communication: We will practice saying the same sentences they will be writing.

Math

We are continuing to count in French. We are going to see how far we can go. Can we make it to 15? We will be looking at different representations of numbers from 1-10 and trying to recognize them as quickly as possible (dots and tally). We will roll a dotted dice or a numbered dice and find the tally number that matches it. We will count objects to 10.
